Type I

- > Oral evaluation: exam
 - > Periodic: for established patient
 - Comprehensive: new patient
- > **Bitewing**: x-rays
 - Four is the most common (two on each side)
- Prophylaxis: cleaning

Hint: Pay attention to the greyed out areas, they will tell you valuable information regarding the listed procedures throughout the manual.

Type II

- > Amalgam: silver filling
- Resin-based composite: tooth colored filling

Hint: For the Economy, Standard or Preferred plans, if a client asks how much we pay towards fillings, give them a range of the least expensive and the most expensive. Let them know we will pay somewhere between those two prices based on the location of the tooth, type of filling and the size of the filling.



Type III

- Periodontal scaling and root planing: deep cleaning
 - Quadrant: The mouth is divided into four quadrants UR, LR, UL, LL.

Hint: Once scaling and root planing has been performed the patient usually needs 3 to 4 cleanings per year. Our policy only pays for 2 per year. The insured will have to pay for the extra cleanings out of their pocket. (This is common with any dental insurance.)

Implants: A titanium post implanted in the bone to replace missing teeth.



Hint: Our policy provides coverage for Implants and Implant Services subject to \$1,000 Lifetime Maximum. See pages 11 and 12 in Dental Reference Manual for details.



The following is a complete list of all covered procedures provided by our dental insurance.

Each plan pays 100% for preventive (type I) services when you see an in-network provider, the only difference between the four plans is what each one pays for basic (type II) and major (type III) benefits.

The Premier Plan (Schedule 4) pays 70% of the maximum allowable charge for basic and major services.

The other three plans – Economy (Schedule 1), Standard (Schedule 2) and Preferred (Schedule 3) – pay a set dollar amount, for basic and major services. With these three plans, the amounts shown for basic and major services are the same regardless of provider participation.

The chart below shows the covered dental procedures Physicians Mutual Insurance Company pays benefits for, as well as the maximum expense paid for each.
